

NOTICE OF ELECTION

UK PARLIAMENTARY ELECTION

ALYN AND DEESIDE CONSTITUENCY

- 1 An election is to be held for a Member to serve in the United Kingdom Parliament for the above Constituency.
- 2 Nomination papers may be obtained at the place mentioned below. The Acting Returning Officer will, at the request of any elector, prepare for signature a nomination paper.
- 3 Nomination Papers must be delivered by prior appointment to the Acting Returning Officer at County Hall, Mold, Flintshire. CH7 6NR between the hours of **10am and 4pm** on any working day (Monday to Friday) after the date of this notice but not later than **4pm on Friday 7 June 2024**.
- 4 A deposit of £500 for each candidate must be paid either in cash, bankers draft (banks operating in the United Kingdom only) or by direct bank transfer
- 5 If the election is contested, the poll will take place on **Thursday 4 July 2024**
- 6 Applications to be added to the Register of Electors in order to vote at this election must reach the **Electoral Registration Officer** (as shown below) by **Tuesday 18 June 2024**. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/register-to-vote.
- 7 Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the **Electoral Registration Officer** (as shown below) by **5pm on Wednesday 19 June 2024**. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote
- 8 Applications to appoint a proxy must reach the **Electoral Registration Officer** (as shown below) by **5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024**. Applications can be made online at www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote
- 9 Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the **Electoral Registration Officer** (as shown below) by **5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024**. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate can be made online www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate.
- 10 Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election on the grounds of physical incapacity or for work / service reasons must reach the **Electoral Registration Officer** (as shown below) by **5pm on Thursday 4 July 2024**. The physical incapacity must have occurred **after 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024**. To apply on the grounds of work / service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person **after 5pm on Wednesday 26 June 2024**.
