

NOTICE OF MAKING

The Flintshire County Council (B5125 Hawarden, Carmel, Ffrith, Sealand and Ysceifiog) (20mph Speed Limit) Order 2023

Unnamed road leading to Gorsedd Farm: for its entire length.

Pennant View, Druids Close, Osprey Court and The Orchard: For their entire lengths.

Ffrith

Cymau Lane: from its junction with High Street, for distance of 55 metres in a south-easterly direction.

B5101 Ffrith: from its junction with the Cymau Lane, for distance of 62 metres north-westerly direction

Sealand

Old Sealand Road: from a point 180 metres south-east of its junction with Seahill Road for a distance of 38 metres.

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE ORDER

The Welsh Government will introduce a national default 20mph speed limit on all restricted roads within Wales from 17th September 2023.

Restricted roads are usually located in residential and built-up areas and have a system of street lighting.

The Authority are reviewing all speed limits within the County, in relation to their suitability to the legislation and the roads within the above list form part of this.

Due to the length of roads contained within this proposed Traffic Regulation Order being in a peripheral area that has no street lighting present for the full extents. Therefore, a 20mph Traffic Regulation Order is proposed, as these roads support the criteria for the suggested advertised speed limit

The Authority continues its responsibility to consider the provision of the convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles and other traffic, and the proposed measures are aimed at ensuring that danger is minimised to road users as well as improving the amenities of the locality.

The proposals are detailed in the Public Notice and are contained in the proposed Draft Orders.
