Notice of Proposal to Construct Road Humps at Leaches Lane, Mancot, Flintshire

NOTICE is hereby given by the Flintshire County Council pursuant to Section 90C of the Highways Act 1980, that it intends to construct Road Cushions pursuant to Section 90A of the said Act in the road mentioned in the Schedule to this Notice.

This proposal consists of the removal of a flat top raised table from the frontages of Nos. 11/13 Leaches Lane, and the installation of Road Cushions at the location shown in the Schedule to this Notice and will in all respects comply with the provisions of the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999.

Reason for Proposal: The existing traffic calming feature at Leaches Lane has been a factor in repeated flooding and drainage issues. This has resulted in ongoing maintenance challenges, adverse impacts on road safety, and potential hazards to road users, particularly during and after periods of heavy rainfall. The existing flat top raised table is to be removed and replaced with Road Speed cushions, which will ensure compliance with highway safety standards, improve drainage efficiency, and maintain the effectiveness of traffic calming measures without exacerbating flooding issues.
