

**THE FLINTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**  
**(OFF-STREET PARKING PLACES –BUCKLEY) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2020**

Notice is hereby given that on the 7<sup>th</sup> January 2020 Flintshire County Council (“the Council”) has made an Order in exercise of its powers under Sections 32, 33, 34, 35 and 35C and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended (“the 1984 Act”) and The Traffic Management Act 2004 (“the 2004 act”) and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the 1984 Act, the effect of which is to amend The Flintshire County Council (Off-Street Parking Places – Buckley) (Revocation) Order 2018, so as to regulate the use of Brunswick Road Car Park in Buckley and provide an area of free parking provision:

(a) The Flintshire County Council (Off Street Parking Places – Buckley) (Revocation) Order 2018 is amended as though the below is deleted from Schedule 2

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instruments made under it has not been complied with, you may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

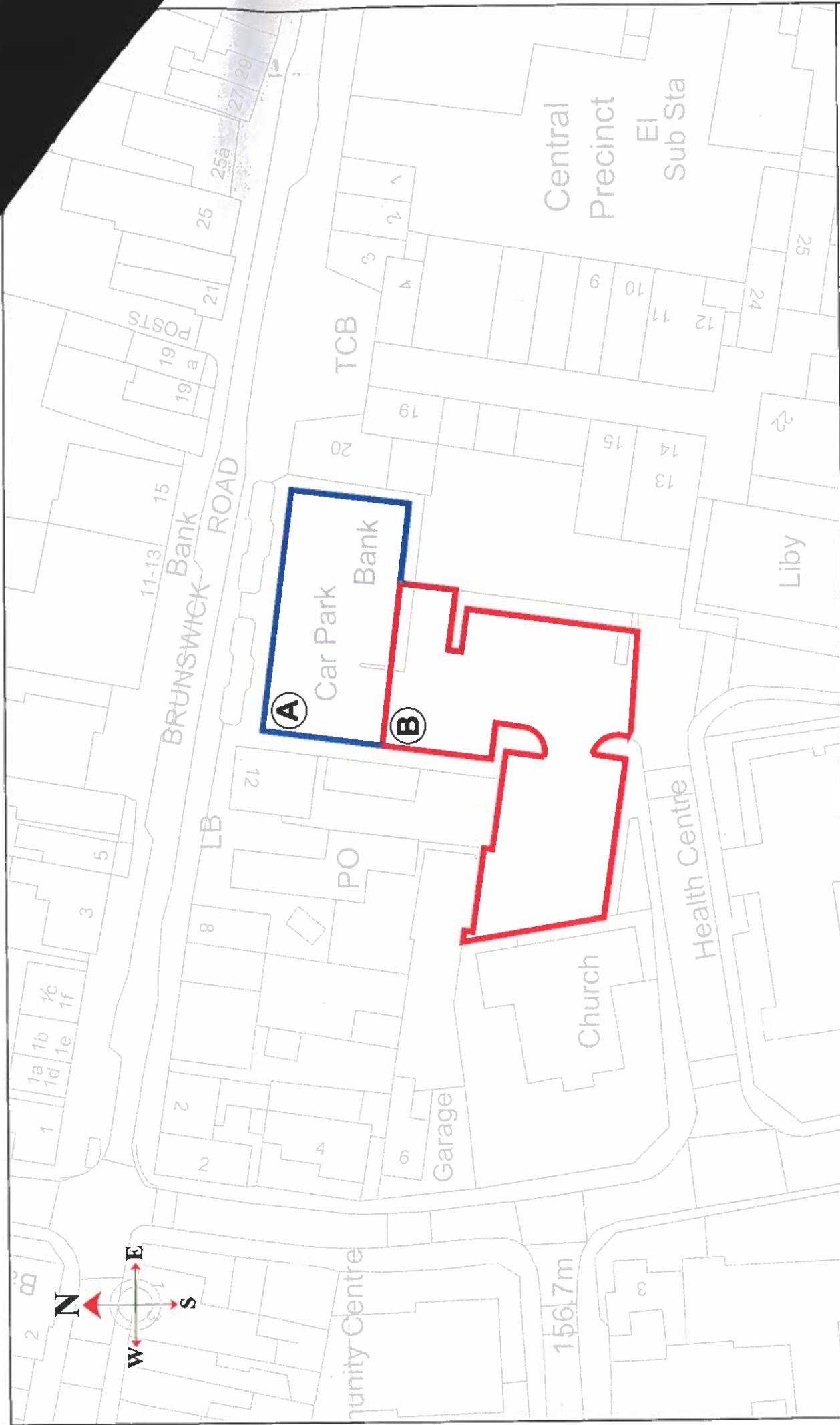

**STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER**

The effect of the proposed Order, is to regulate the use of Brunswick Road Car Park in Buckley, by introducing an area of free parking provision, to improve the vibrancy and vitality of the town centre by providing free short stay parking.

Off-street parking places (car parks) are provided by the Council to help and relieve the congestion of traffic and to assist traffic management by reducing the demand for on-street parking places.

The proposals are detailed in the Public Notice and are contained in the proposed draft order.
